The best THREE scratch scores on the day will be asked to represent London at the Scratch Championship Final on Wednesday 10 September at Pannal GC (Harrogate)

CSSC will pay the travel costs of all three qualifiers but only the green fees & accommodation (2 nights dinner, bed & breakfast) of two. The qualifiers will, therefore be asked to pay a percentage towards the costs of the third qualifier to make up the difference. The best THREE handicap scores on the day will be asked to represent London at the Handicap Championship Final on Thursday 7th August at Stoneham GC (Southampton).

CSSC will pay the travel costs of all three qualifiers but only the green fees & accommodation (2 nights dinner, bed & breakfast) of two. The qualifiers will, therefore be asked to pay a percentage towards the costs of the third qualifier to make up the difference.
